## game time: guess the word

## description

You can play this game in a classroom, outdoor learning space, or anywhere! This is a great opportunity to practice language in a relaxed environment, make mistakes, and have fun together!

## steps

- Prepare a list of words for players to guess: a rabbit, a lamp, a plane, a pirate, any word!
- Explain the rules of the game:
  - One person thinks, acts out or describes a word
  - Players ask questions until they guess the word: is it round? Is it alive? Do you have one in your house?
  - Players or teams get points each time they guess correctly. The player or team with the highest number of points wins.
- **3** Keep it fast-paced, with many opportunities for questions and answers. Encourage students to speak in the target language as much as possible.

## protip

Brainstorm a list of sentence frames players can use to ask questions: Is it \_\_\_\_? Can it \_\_\_? Write them on the board so students can refer to them while asking questions.
